

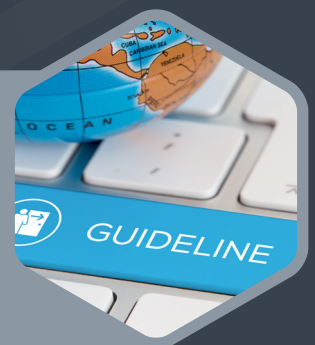
# LIVING GUIDELINES



“ Awareness of cochlear implants among primary and hearing healthcare providers is inadequate, leading to under-identification of eligible candidates. Clearer referral and candidacy pathways would help increase access to cochlear implants<sup>1</sup> ”

A newly formed global Task Force consisting of 50 hearing professionals and recipients from 21 countries calls for a consistent standard of care for adults with severe to profound hearing loss, to access referral pathways and treatment with cochlear implants
